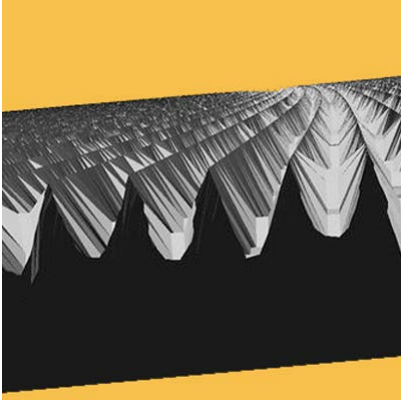
Liverpool to Get Pressing Plant
